Legislative

The NHRLA Legislative Committee, under the guidance of Bob Jackman and in close collaboration with lobbyist Curtis Barry, maintains active connections with state legislators and the Governor's office in 2024. Our primary focus this year centers on addressing the critical issue of lumber grading, specifically SPF versus SPFs. This distinction significantly impacts many of our members, exemplified by the unique scenario where a tree harvested in New Hampshire is split, with one half sent to a Canadian mill and the other to a local mill. Astonishingly, the Canadian-milled lumber is graded SPF, while the New England-milled lumber is graded SPFs, causing complications, and increasing the cost of business.

Nationally, ABMA, powered by NRLA and CSA, continues to advocate for our members on vital issues like the Softwood Lumber Agreement, tax matters (including the bonus depreciation tax credit), and the Employer Directed Skills Act. These priorities have a direct impact on the broader LBM industry, influencing the tax environment, supply chains, and business investments. Your continued engagement is essential as we collectively navigate and shape the future of the New Hampshire lumber industry.
