

LEGISLATIVE

The New Jersey Building Materials Dealers Association's Legislative Committee, led by Chair Steve Gerard and lobbyist Scot Mackey, focuses on advocating for the lumber and building materials industry in New Jersey. It maintains strong ties with the Governor's office and Legislature, addressing key issues such as affordability and the state's challenging business climate, which ranks dead last nationally. The committee champions sensible legislation to lower property taxes, promote workforce development, and address concerns regarding all-electric buildings. It emphasizes setting realistic goals while advocating for measures that balance environmental considerations with economic viability. By providing a tempered perspective, the committee ensures legislative efforts align with the industry's practical needs and the state's broader interests.

Nationally, ABMA, powered by NRLA and CSA, continues to advocate for our members on vital issues like the Softwood Lumber Agreement, tax matters (including the bonus depreciation tax credit), Employer Directed Skills Act, and lower credit card processing fees. These priorities have a direct impact on the broader LBM industry, influencing the tax environment, supply chains, and business investments. Your continued engagement is essential as we collectively navigate and shape the future of New Jersey's LBM industry.

SUPPORT

One purpose of the NJBMDA is to encourage high levels of professional standards and education in the industry. To support this goal, the association offers \$1,000 education subsidy to members participating in NRLA's online learning management system, virtual classes, and in person education.
