David Beattie, the 2024 Lumber Person of the Year, has built a distinguished career in the lumber industry, drawing inspiration from a family legacy rooted in hard work and dedication. In 2002, while working on a margin desk at an online brokerage firm, David found himself dissatisfied with his career path. A conversation with his father led to an opportunity as a Product Specialist at Parksite, marking the beginning of a career that has spanned over two decades.

David's professional journey has taken him through key roles at several leading companies, including Parksite (2002-2008), BB&S (2008-2009), WOLF Home Products (2010-2017), BlueLinx (2017-2024), and Coastal Forest Products (2024-Present). His diverse experiences have shaped him into a highly respected figure in the industry, with a focus on sales, management, and customer relationships.

Throughout his career, David has been deeply involved in the New England lumber community, serving in various capacities within the Rhode Island Lumber and Building Material Dealers Association (RILBMDA). As a young man, he was taught that success in the lumber industry required passion and commitment— something he's carried with him throughout his career. David has often reflected on the advice his father gave him: "You are either going to love this business or hate it, there really isn't any middle ground."
