### LEGISLATIVE

The NJBMDA Legislative Committee, led by Steve Gerard and Lobbyist Scot Mackey, is actively defending New Jersey's LBM industry—most recently by opposing the diesel truck phase-out that began January 1, 2025. Over 100 member letters helped prompt House approval of a two-year delay; efforts now focus on Senate and Governor support.

Nationally, the American Building Materials Alliance (ABMA) has strengthened its advocacy with a new lobbying team. Top issues include tax policy, credit card fees, and workforce development. ABMA is also actively involved in OSHA rulemaking, ensuring the industry's voice is heard on key regulations like the Heat Injury Prevention Standard.

### SUPPORT

One purpose of the NJBMDA is to encourage high levels of professional standards and education in the industry. To support this goal, the association offers \$1,000 education credit to members participating in NRLA's online learning management system, virtual classes, and in person education. NJBMDA offers financial support for other events including the annual Timber Tour, Legislative Conference and the LBM Expo.
